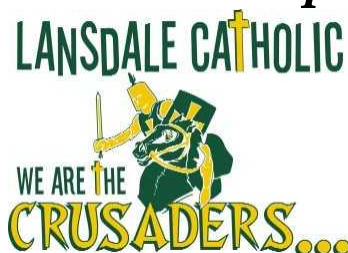


Lansdale Catholic High School Community Service Corps 2009-2010
