Dear Parents and Guardians,

It is becoming a growing problem here at Lansdale Catholic that students are texting or calling you without the schools permission. This is in direct violation of our code of conduct as well as the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's policy on cell phone usage.

If your child needs to talk to you or is not feeling well they must go to the Nurse, the Attendance Office, see me or any other Administrator to seek permission. Lansdale Catholic has no problem with letting a student call their parents or guardians if it is warranted. But having parents or guardians just show up at the Main Office because their child called or texts them without the schools knowledge is unacceptable. We are very prudent in our student's health and safety.

As of tomorrow, any student that calls or texts their parent or guardian without the schools permission will be in violation of the cell phone policy and will receive the fine amount accordingly that goes with the current violation. Please encourage your children to notify school personnel before calling or texting you. Please make them aware of the safety concerns as well as the stress this can cause on you also.
